Gun Raffle Rules as of 4/23/2026

1. Raffle tickets shall be sold for twenty dollars (\$20.00) each. Purchasers are not required to be present to win.
2. Participants must be at least eighteen (18) years of age to purchase raffle tickets, including 50/50 raffle tickets.
3. For online purchases only, six (6) raffle tickets may be purchased for one hundred dollars (\$100.00), fifteen (15) raffle tickets for two hundred dollars (\$200.00), or fifty (50) raffle tickets for five hundred dollars (\$500.00), all of which must be issued in the same individual's name. 50/50 raffle tickets shall be sold for ten dollars (\$10.00) each or twelve (12) tickets for one hundred dollars (\$100.00).
4. All raffle entries must include the purchaser's full legal name, phone number, email address, and the seller's name. Entries that are incomplete, inaccurate, or illegible shall be deemed invalid and ineligible for the drawing.
5. Abou Ben Adhem shall not be responsible for entries that are lost, late, misdirected, incomplete, or otherwise not received, regardless of cause.
6. The award of ninety (90) firearms and ten (10) gift cards is contingent upon the sale of a minimum of four thousand (4,000) valid raffle tickets. If fewer than 4,000 tickets are sold, the number of prizes awarded shall be proportionally reduced based on the ratio of tickets sold to the minimum requirement. Such determination shall be final and binding.
7. The odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible tickets sold.
8. Any winner who does not meet all applicable federal, state (including Missouri law), and local requirements to legally purchase, possess, or own a firearm shall forfeit the prize. No substitute prize or cash equivalent shall be provided, except as expressly set forth herein.
9. At the sole and absolute discretion of Abou Ben Adhem, a winner may be offered the option to receive a firearm buy-back amount of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00 USD) in lieu of accepting the firearm.
10. Abou Ben Adhem reserves the right to delay or refuse firearm transfer to any individual who is reasonably believed to be under the influence of alcohol, controlled substances, or otherwise impaired, consistent with safe handling practices and applicable law. Such determination shall be final.
11. A complete list of winners will be published on the Abou Ben Adhem website (abashrine.com). Winners not present at the drawing will be notified the same day

using the contact information provided. Prizes may be claimed during normal business hours at The Gun Company, 432 S. Mill St., Suite 104, Rogersville, MO 65742.

12. Any winner requesting shipment of a firearm shall be responsible for all associated shipping, handling, insurance, and transfer costs. Firearms must be shipped to a Federal Firearms License (FFL) dealer in compliance with all federal and Missouri laws.
13. Winners are solely responsible for arranging transfer through a licensed FFL dealer in their state of residence and for complying with all applicable federal, state, and local laws. Abou Ben Adhem is not responsible for delays or denials resulting from background checks or legal restrictions.
14. All prizes must be claimed on or before January 1, 2027. Any unclaimed prizes after this date shall be deemed forfeited and become the sole property of Abou Ben Adhem.
15. Abou Ben Adhem reserves the right to substitute any listed firearm or prize with one of equal or greater value due to availability or supply constraints.
16. All raffle entries must be made in the purchaser's full legal name. Entries submitted under business names, fictitious names, aliases, or group names shall be deemed invalid.
17. Winners are solely responsible for all federal, state, and local taxes, fees, and reporting requirements associated with prize winnings, including but not limited to IRS reporting. Winners agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Abou Ben Adhem from any related liabilities, claims, or penalties.
18. Clubs, units, or organizations shall retain five dollars (\$5.00) per paper ticket sold prior to remitting funds and ticket stubs. Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per ticket must accompany all submitted ticket stubs. All sold ticket stubs must be returned to the Temple no later than 11:00 a.m. on the day of the drawing. The drawing shall begin promptly at 12:00 p.m. Online sales commissions will be reconciled and reimbursed following the close of sales. All ticket sales are final, and no refunds shall be permitted.
19. All unsold tickets issued must be returned by 11:00 a.m. on the day of the drawing. Tickets should be returned in numerical order to the extent practicable.
20. All Abou Ben Adhem clubs and units must cease any independent firearm raffle activities no later than August 1, 2026, to maintain compliance with organizational governance and applicable regulations.
21. The 50/50 raffle winner shall receive fifty percent (50%) of net proceeds collected, after deduction of applicable processing fees. The winner is solely responsible for all taxes and reporting requirements.

22. Proceeds are for the benefit of Abou Ben Adhem Shriners. Payments or donations are not deductible as charitable contributions. Entrants agree to hold harmless Abou Ben Adhem Shriners from any loss, damage or injuries.
